




**Berlin – Dresden – Prague – Salzburg – Fussen – Strasbourg – Heilderberg**

### Day 1 – Berlin

Arrival to Berlin – capital city of Germany will be followed with guided city tour in the once-divided city into capitalist West part and communist East part by the Berlin wall. City tour features

**Tiegarten park, Berlin Wall with Checkpoint Charlie** - the best known Berlin Wall crossing point between East and West Berlin, **Brandenburg Gate** - the best known landmark of Germany, **Postdamer Platz, Gemäldegalerie** with one of the world's best collection of European paintings, **Neue Nationalgalerie** museum of modern art, **Charlottenburg** with the largest surviving royal place in Berlin). In the evening transfer to the hotel.

### Day 2 –Berlin – Dresden - Prague

In the morning departure from Berlin to Prague. On our way we will stop in Dresden the capital of Saxony, still known as a Florence on the Elbe. Set in gorgeous landscape in the Elbe Valley it has been for years one of the cultural centre in Germany. City tour includes: **Zwinger Palace** with gardens, Semper Opera House, large mural artwork Procession of Princes and Dresden Castle.

Afterwards we will continue to Prague. Prague is one of the most beautiful city in the world with its pitoresque atmosphere located just in the heart of Europe. The historical centre that ranks among the most significant monuments of cultural heritage survived the violence and destruction of world wars intact unlike many other european cities. City tour includes: **Prague Castle** (unique castle complex), **St. Vitus Cathedral, Golden Lane, Charles Bridge** (famous historic bridge decorated by alley of statues), **Old Town Square, Astronomical Clock** (the oldest still operating medieval astronomical clock), **Church of Our Lady before Tyn, Wenceslas Square.**

### Day 3 – Prague – trip to Karlovy Vary

Trip to Karlovy Vary – spa town situated in Western Bohemia. In the 19th century many famous people came here from all around the Europe for treatment, among them Goethe, Beethoven, Chopin or Karel Marx. Karlovy Vary are famous for its colonnades. On a walk around the city you will have an opportunity to sip the thermal water or have the famous spa waffles.

After the return back to Prague you have possibility to join extra dinner in **Detenice restaurant** – medieval tavern that will take you back to Middle Ages. Dancers and swordmen will provide you with a night of entertainment.

#### **Day 4 – Prague - Salzburg**

In the morning we will set off to Salzburg - one of the most beautiful cities in Europe with its magnificent Baroque downtown rated as a UNESCO World Cultural Heritage site. City is surrounded by spectacular landscape. City tour upon arrival will include Old Town with **Salzburg Cathedral**, **Getreidegasse** most famous shopping line in Salzburg that still retains medieval atmosphere with its narrow houses and iron guild signs, their biggest fortress in the Central Europe **Hohensalzburg Fortress** from where you can enjoy beautiful views.

#### **Day 5 – Salzburg - Fussen**

On this day we will visit 2 magnificent Royal Castles - Neuschwanstein and Hohenschwangau set at the foot of the mountains. Not by surprise **Neuschwanstein** is one of the most famous castle in the world. The castle is located on the top of a hill and looks like from a fairytale. **Hohenschwangau** Castle rebuildied in Gothic style is another famous castle decorated with scenes from prehistoric age and figures from mythology.

Fussun town in Bavaria with more than 700 years of history on the Alp's foothill. You can visit plenty of places in Fussen, Hohes Schloss Castle, baroque churches.

#### **Day 6 – Fussen – Strasbourg**

In the morning we will set off to Strasbourg. The city of Strasbourg is located in Eastern France on the boarder with Germany. Strasbourg's historic centre is on the List of world heritage UNESCO and is influenced both by German and French tradition. The city is also seat of several European institutions. City tour will include sights such as **Cathedrale Notre Dame** de Strasbourg, historic quatre of the city **Petite France** with bridge **Ponts Couverts** or the largest square of the city **Klebér Square**.

#### **Day 7 - Strasbourg – Heilderberg**

We will croos the boarders back to Germany and visit city of Heidelberg. The city is famous for its romantic atmosphere, green hills, beautiful riverside and historic monuments. We will visit **Old Town – Altstadt** where you can discover unspoiled medieval architecture, **Karl Theodore Bridge** and of course the main landmark **Heidelberg Castle** that sits on a hill overlooking the city.

#### **Day 8 Heilderberg – Stuttgart - Departure**

Transfer from Heidelberg to Stuttgart. Departure from Stuttgart to home destination.
